CAN MIMOSA

From the cabana guesthouse, papered in the Beverly Hills Hotel's banana-leaf print, to the bamboo furniture, British interior-designer owner Caroline Legrand has the retro-tropical look so bang on you'll want a tiki cocktail as soon as you arrive. In the main house, marble floors make the coolest foil for mid-century and quirky Seventies finds. Outside, the terrace unfolds into gardens, scented by mimosa, with a pool tiled in Yves Klein blue. Overlooking it is a tiered chill-out and dining spot that's sun-soaked by day and lantern-lit by night, with its own bar and barbecue. The house is near San José in the heart of the south-westerly Golden Triangle (the best beaches, sunsets, and a hop from Ibiza Town and the airport), and five minutes' drive from seafood star Es Torrent and the Blue Marlin beach club.
